### Washington Discover Pass

Washington State requires a Discover Pass at Washington State Parks, Washington State Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) lands, and Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) areas.

A Washington Discover Pass is required at the following locations.

#### BEACON ROCK STATE PARK

including:

- › Beacon Rock Trail
- › River to Rock Trail
- › Hamilton Mountain Trail
- › Hardy and Rodney (Pool of the Winds) Falls Trail
- › Hardy Ridge Trail
