

# PERMITS and PASSES

- **MULTNOMAH FALLS:** Between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend, between the hours of 9am and 6pm there is a timed use permitting that goes into effect for those arriving by personal vehicle at the Multnomah Falls I-84 Exit 31 parking lot. Permits will be available two weeks prior to the date you wish to visit at [recreation.gov](http://recreation.gov). There is a \$2 reservation fee. The Gateway to the Gorge Visitor Center in Troutdale and the Cascade Locks Historical Museum each have 25 free in-person permits available daily on a first come, first served basis. If parking at the lot across from the Multnomah Falls Lodge on the historic highway, there is a fee year round. - **LOWER LEWIS RIVER FALLS** requires a Northwest Forest Pass mid-June through Labor Day. *In addition* to a reserved \$2 day visit ticket. • **DOG MOUNTAIN TRAILHEAD** hiker and parking permits are required on Saturdays and Sundays from mid-April to mid-June and Memorial Day. A NW Forest Pass is required for parking *in addition* to a hiker permit. A hiker permit is automatically included with the shuttle bus from Stevenson, WA. [ridecatbus.org](http://ridecatbus.org)
